## Glen Helen Raptor Center Presents OWLS OF OHIO



September 8th at 9am  
at Wild Birds Unlimited Springboro

Betty Ross from the Glen Helen Raptor Center will be here at the store with a few of her feathered owl friends to share her knowledge about these interesting birds.

The Raptor Center rehabilitates injured birds of prey, and educates the public about raptors, other wildlife, and conservation issues.

Through its rehabilitation efforts, the Raptor Center admits 150-200 birds of prey each year for rehabilitation and is able to release more than half of them back into the wild. Through its education efforts, the Center reaches thousands of people each year who hopefully gain a greater understanding, appreciation, and concern for raptors and other wildlife.

The Raptor Center began in 1970 as part of Antioch College's Glen Helen Outdoor Education Center. The Raptor Center includes a classroom area for bird study lessons, an intensive care room, outdoor cages for display of permanently handicapped birds, and flight cages for recuperating birds. A permanent staff person directs activities, naturalist interns assist in the care of the birds, and veterinarians donate their services and expertise.

Funding for the Center is through donations, adoptions, and program fees. While we do not charge for this presentation, we will collect donations for the Center at the register. And be sure to pick up your FREE Owls of Ohio CD & Guidebook, provided by The Ohio Division of Wildlife, while supplies last.

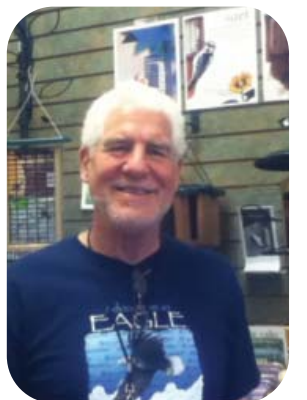

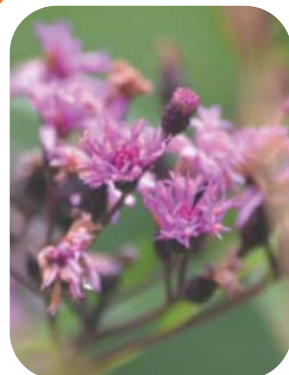
